Prayer Brings Surrender - Part 1

I am a very selfish man. The hardest thing for me to do is give myself up - surrender. But once I did surrender to Jesus, I can say it's the best high I've ever been on...and I've been on a lot of highs.

I was brought up in a loving third-generation Adventist family. I was taught everything I needed to be taught. My grandmother lived with us for 25 years, and could that woman pray! I remember seeing her kneeling every day and wondering how she could stay on her knees so long. Every Friday morning grandma would get up and say, "You know what today is, right? It's preparation day. The day before the Sabbath." I remember coming in from the barn on Fridays and sliding across the clean fresh waxed floor. As a kid it felt good growing up in that atmosphere.

Life went on, and while attending public school I found I really liked to have a good time. I would ask my mom if I could go to the dances on Friday night, and other things. When she said no I was never satisfied with her answer. "Why," I asked myself. "Why among all the people in

this little dinky town we live in, did I have to be brought up a Seventh-day Adventist?" I had this war going on in my head because I knew the things I was drawn to were wrong. Satan knows our most vulnerable times and he kept saying, "Rob, go to the dance...Rob, go ahead and do this...go ahead and try that..."

I started drinking when I was 14. In high school a friend of mine said, "Here, try this. You'll get high and you won't throw up like with drinking." So that's how my high school years went. My last year of high school I remember

a neighbor girl asking me, "Rob, what are you going to do when you finish high school?" I just looked at her. I didn't think ahead. I was just going to keep having fun. I thought the next years were going to be some of the best times of my life; but as Satan would have it they were some of the worst times of my life. His offer of happiness is a straight out lie!

For the next five years I partied every night of the week, working odd jobs here and there, just enough to get what I wanted. People would ask, "Rob, what kind of drugs have you done?" I would say, "Let's just start with the ones I haven't tried. It'll be faster."

I remember driving home after partying and seeing the lights on in my house. I'd be so ashamed of myself that I'd drive on by and sit at the end of the road in my car and cry. I was waiting for the lights to go off so I could go back home. I knew mom was praying for me. There were little kids at home that looked up to their uncle Rob. They loved him. I didn't want them to see me the way I was.

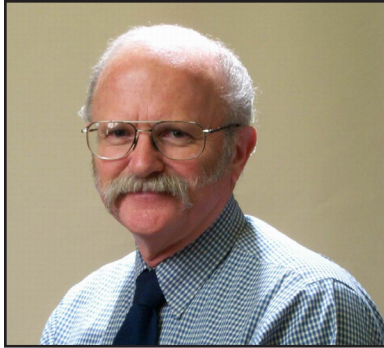
YOUNG ADULT SPEAKER

New Food Service Director for Camp Meeting

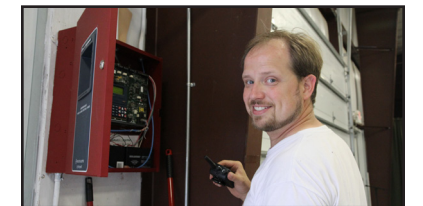
