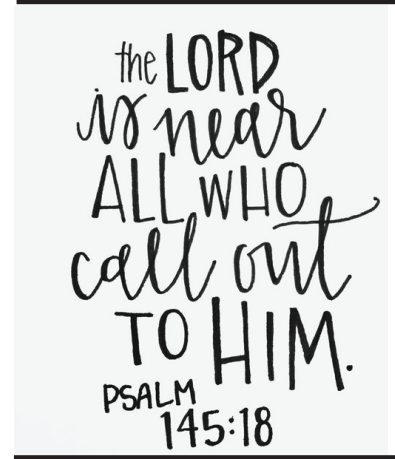

## First English Lay Seminary Held in North America

In February of this year, Wisconsin Conference became the first conference in the North American Division to provide the Adventist Lay Seminary program to their English speaking members, graduating over 25 English speaking lay people. At the same time over 60 Wisconsin Hispanic members graduated from the Adventist Lay Seminary program, a first for the Wisconsin Hispanics.

This program, offered through Andrews University and co-sponsored by the Wisconsin Conference, involves approximately 40 hours of training over seven months. It is designed to equip lay members to join full time pastoral forces in disseminating the Adventist message. The program was founded in 2005 by the Andrews University Institute of Hispanic Ministry, under the direction of Dr. Ricardo Norton, for the Hispanic community. Now this seven-certificate program is available to the English speaking community as well.

"People loved it," said Pastor Nate Skaife, English coordinator for the Adventist Lay Seminary and Personal Ministries. "They

appreciated the Biblical depth of the information they received. The teachers, all required to have a doctorate degree, really challenged and stretched them in their understanding. Every month they had homework assignments which included using the information they were learning by holding Bible studies and sharing. Some were nervous about it, but they were glad they did it."

This year the English certification, which begins this Sunday of Wisconsin camp meeting, will focus on small groups. Come to the Fireside Lodge for the first class which begins at 9:30 a.m.

"We believe in the ministry of our lay people," said Wisconsin Conference President Mike Edge. "Together with our pastors and teachers, our members are our greatest resource. This program will help both our English and Spanish speaking members be more effective for Jesus."
