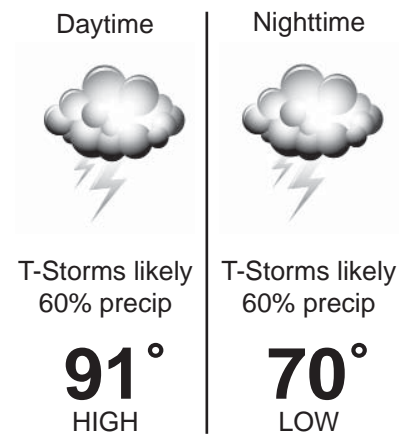

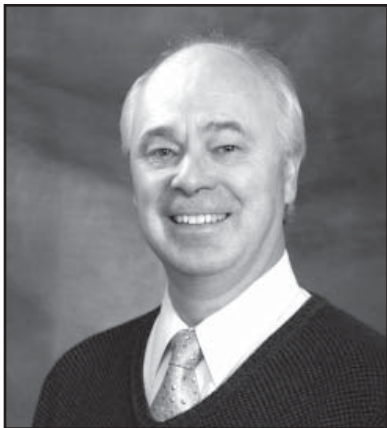
I have also taught this health course to students in public schools. A Catholic organization recently called and asked me to do my health presentation for them this coming July. When I teach these classes I only use Scripture.
