It's Time to Commune with God

Recently Mike and I took our two oldest granddaughters to spend the day at Gibbs Gardens, a lovely 300 acre oasis where every kind of beautiful flower and plant you can imagine blooms. The girls loved being among the beautifully groomed trees, streams, and flowers.

That evening, when looking through the hundreds of pictures I took, I noticed one picture of Amelia, our oldest granddaughter, holding a pink flower blossom to her nose. Her eyes were closed and she had the most pleasant expression on her face. It was quite enchanting and I wondered what she was thinking about. So I asked her, and in her quiet sweet voice she said, "Oh, grandma, I felt so happy, and was thanking Jesus for making such beautiful flowers and letting me be here to enjoy them." It touched my heart to see her spontaneous response to God speaking to her heart through the beauty around her. She was communing with her Creator.

I believe God is attempting to communicate with each of us in multiple ways, multiple times, every day. I believe He longs for each of us to hear Him and respond. Do I miss His voice sometimes? The root word of communication is commune. Webster says commune means to communicate with someone



in a very personal or spiritual way. To be in close accord. Do I have that kind of a connection with Jesus? Do you?

How precious! The soul communing with God!... Sweet and abiding will be the influence emanating from Him who seeth in secret, whose ear is open to answer the prayer arising from the
